Ring Size Guide

1/How to measure using an existing ring

1. Print this guide on **A4 paper at 100% scale**. Please ensure the **'fit to page'** option is not selected.
2. Find a ring that fits the ring finger and place it over the circles below.
3. Move between sizes until you find the circle that aligns precisely with the internal edge of your ring.
4. The correct size is the one where the circle fits flush within the ring with no visible gaps or overlay.

2/How to measure your finger

1. Cut out the ring size strip and the slit as shown.
2. Wrap the strip around the base of your ring finger and thread the end through the slit.
3. Gently adjust for a comfortable fit it should feel snug but not too tight
4. The correct ring size is indicated by the letter aligned with the arrow.
